

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF CONTRACT BID12015
TO COPPOLA SERVICES, INC.
UNDER THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR
THE PRINCESS DRIVE SANITARY PUMP STATION
BYPASS PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works Sewer Division is responsible for providing maintenance and repairs to the municipal sanitary system including pump stations; and

WHEREAS, due to the perpetual flow through the Princess Drive sanitary pump station, Director of Public Works Glenn Sandor had made a recommendation to install a bypass in the system in the event there is a failure; and

WHEREAS, the Township previously has engaged the services of municipal engineer, CME Associates, to provide the engineering design work relating to this project, including design, engineering, bidding and construction management; and

WHEREAS, this project will be funded from existing Sewer Capital Ordinances 05-17, 06-18, 08-21, 09-17 and 11-17; and

WHEREAS, on June 4, 2012 the Township Council of the Township of North Brunswick approved Resolution 198-6.12 authorizing advertisement for receipt of bids for the Princess Drive Pump Station Bypass Project - BID12015; and

WHEREAS, the Deputy Municipal Clerk witnessed the receipt of five bids on July 12, 2012 and the lowest qualifying bid was submitted by Coppola Services, Inc. of Ringwood, New Jersey with a base bid of \$216,889.45 for items 1 through 10 inclusive; and

WHEREAS, CME Associates, Engineers for this project, Purchasing, and Legal Counsel have reviewed the qualifications and bid submitted by Coppola Services, Inc. and determined them responsive under the provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.) and all other provisions of the revised statutes of the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works has also reviewed the bid proposal and recommends approval of the bid submitted by Coppola Services, Inc.; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the bid of Coppola Services, Inc. is hereby accepted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, on this 6th day of August, 2012 that the Township Council of the Township of North Brunswick does hereby authorize the Mayor to execute and the Township Clerk to witness an agreement with Coppola Services, Inc. for the Princess Drive Pump Station Bypass Project - BID12015
