

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BRUNSWICK  
AUTHORIZING A CHANGE IN SCOPE TO  
THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH  
CME ASSOCIATES APPOINTED AS THE 2015  
TOWNSHIP CONSULTING ENGINEERS TO INCLUDE  
SURVEY, BASE MAPPING AND DESIGN THROUGH BID PHASE SERVICES FOR  
THE HOW LANE PUMP STATION IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, resolution 4-1.15 approved by the Township Council authorized CME Associates, of 3141 Bordentown Avenue, Parlin, NJ 08959, to provide engineering consulting services for calendar year 2015, as awarded under a fair and open contract process, pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.1 et seq.; and

**WHEREAS**, CME Associates current agreement includes general engineering services to be provided to the Township as Consulting Engineers in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00, 2014 Tax Map Maintenance and Update Services for a not to exceed amount of \$4,236.00, Route 130 Construction Phase Services for amount not to exceed amount of \$59,644.00, Construction Phase Services for the 2015 Road Program Project for an amount not to exceed \$254,858.00, and Construction Phase Services for Nassau Street Improvements for a amount not to exceed amount of \$94,322.00 for a revised contract amount of \$513,109.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the existing How Lane Pump Station is in need of upgrades that include: converting to a submersible type station, installing a new generator, and a valve/by-pass chamber and controls building; and

**WHEREAS**, Eric Chaszar, the Director for the Department of Public Works, has requested additional services of CME Associates to include Survey, Base Mapping and Design through Bid Phase Services for the How Lane Pump Station Improvements Project; and

**WHEREAS**, compensation for said services shall be based upon the August 19, 2015 proposal submitted by CME Associates as follows:

Phase I:	Survey, Base Mapping and Design Phase	\$44,083.00
Phase II:	Permits	\$22,867.00
Phase III:	Soil Borings	\$ 4,350.00
Phase IV:	Bid Phase	<u>\$ 3,908.00</u>
Total for Phases I-IV:		<u>\$75,208.00</u>


**WHEREAS**, the engineering services for this project will be funded from existing sewer capital ordinances.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** on this 21<sup>st</sup> day of September, 2015 that the Township Council of the Township of North Brunswick does hereby authorize the Mayor to execute and the Township Clerk to witness an amendment to the current agreement with CME Associates to include Survey, Base Mapping and Design through Bid Phase Services for the How Lane Pump Station Improvements Project for a not to exceed amount of \$75,208.00 for a revised contract amount of \$588,317.00.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** notice of this action shall be published in the Home News & Tribune as required by law within 10 (ten) days after its passage.
