



## **NO PARKING ON SNOW EMERGENCY STREETS/OFF STREET PARKING INFORMATION**

Residents are advised to move all vehicles off the streets in order for Department of Public Works crews to clean the roadways. They will be up working for you through the storm so it's the least we can do to make their job a little easier. It also allows for wider paths in case of emergency traffic.

Residents who live on a designated Snow Emergency street must remove their vehicle from the street. Township Police will strictly enforce this no parking ban and cars will be towed for those who do not comply.

Below is a list of snow emergency streets:

- Cranbury Cross Road
- Hermann Road
- Nassau Street
- Newton Street
- Ridgewood Avenue
- Aaron Road
- Independence Boulevard (both sides of Rt. 130)
- Hartland Commons
- Hidden Lake Drive
- Schmidt Lane
- Willowbrook Drive
- Axel Avenue
- Woodland Ave. (from Jerome terminus to Stevens Street)

Cleremont Avenue  
Carlisle Road  
Masoma Road  
Serviss Avenue (from intersection of Stevens St. to dead end of Serviss Avenue)  
Beverly Avenue (from Oakwood Place to Livingston Avenue)  
Beechwood Place (from Glenridge Avenue to Cleremont Avenue)  
North Oaks Boulevard

Below is a list of partial snow emergency streets:

- Linwood Place: both sides of street in an area between Hermann Road and Cranbury Cross Road intersections;
- Linwood Place: both sides of street in an area between Glenridge Avenue and Woodland Avenue intersections
- Wood Avenue: both sides of street beginning at Route 130 intersection continuing to the emergency access gate into Birchwood Court at Wood Avenue terminus
- Haverford Street: both sides of street in an area between Lee Avenue and Livingston Avenue intersections
- Stevens Street: both sides of street in an area between Lee Avenue and Livingston Avenue intersections
- Huron Road: both sides of street in an area between Axel Avenue and Jersey Avenue intersections
- Riverbend Drive: one side of street designated by posted No Parking – Snow Emergency signs
- Village Drive East: western curb face of roadway designated by posted No Parking – Snow Emergency signs
- Village Drive South: northern curb face of roadway designated by posted No Parking – Snow Emergency signs
- Village Drive West: eastern curb face of roadway designated by posted No Parking – Snow Emergency signs

Please note that the lack of a 'No Parking Snow Emergency' sign on any of the described streets shall NOT be construed to mean that parking is permitted during snow emergencies.

Off street parking for residents will be available at the following locations:

- Community Park, enter from Adams Lane ONLY
- Sabella Park
- Babbage Park, at the Glenridge Avenue entrance
- JFK Park, located on Schmidt Lane
