



WINTER STORM REMINDERS AND SAFETY TIPS FOR RESIDENTS

The following is important winter storm information for all residents:

The Township will have an operations center open during the storm. Please call (732) 247-7272 for storm related information.

In case of power outages, please contact the utility company (PSE&G) directly at 1-800-436-7734. You can also visit their website at https://www.pseg.com/home/customer_service/outage_info/outage_grid.jsp. Please do not tie up police emergency phone lines with these calls. If you have an emergency, please call 911.

Make sure that flashlights are operational with extra batteries and you have extra blankets. If you have a generator, do not use it indoors or in a garage.

Please do NOT throw snow into the street when clearing your property.

If you live near a fire hydrant, please help the Fire Department and your neighbors, by shoveling around the hydrant. This could be a life saving measure!

Only travel if ABSOLUTELY necessary. Please do not put yourself or others in danger unnecessarily.

If you or a loved one requires the services of personal care assistance, home health aide, visiting nurse, or other medical professional in their home, please discuss the upcoming weather conditions today with your care provider to assure that adequate arrangements can be made for the next few days.

Assist people who require special assistance such as the elderly living alone and people with disabilities and children.
